The application email must include the following as attached files: i) application for admission, ii) B.A. degree, iii) transcript, including all the classes and grades, as well as the final grade, of the applicant, iv) detailed CV, v) foreign language degrees (Proficiency, IELTS, etc.; minimum: B2 level in English), vi) statement of research interests with a section of relevant bibliography, vii) sample of written work (one (1) seminar essay or B.A. thesis), viii) proof of identity (passport of identity card), ix) any other document that the applicant may deem relevant.

Applicants must also see to it that at least two (2) professors send letters of reference about them **directly** to **history-archaeology@ia.uoc.gr**

Interviews, either by Skype or physical presence in Rethymno, will be arranged after the applications have been examined.

Successful applicants will be required to provide hard copies of their applications.

Applicants are required to be holders of B.A. degrees from university departments or programs in the Humanities or the Social Sciences. The applications of holders of other B.A. degrees may be admitted only if their B.A. studies are relevant to Ottoman History or if they have successfully completed a fair number of classes of Ottoman history.

A maximum number of ten (10) students will be admitted to the Program.

The results of the selection procedure will be announced on **Monday 23 July 2018**. Classes will start on 24 September 2018.
