The 4<sup>th</sup> Meeting for the Archaeological Work in Crete will be completed with the publication of the Proceedings, consisting of two volumes, which will be distributed to the participants during the 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting. Scholars specialized in different fields, members of the Greek Archaeological Service, the Foreign Archaeological Schools as well as academic staff from various Universities, presented the results of their recent research, demonstrating the wide range of the archaeological activities conducted on the island.

With the present circular, we are pleased to announce the upcoming 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting for the Archaeological Workin Crete. The Meeting, jointly organized by the Ephorate of Antiquities of Rethymno and the Department of History and Archaeology, University of Crete, will be held in Rethymno, on November 22-24<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The presentation of the work of the archaeological Institutions should not exceed 25 minutes. The other presentations should not exceed 15 minutes. d. restoration and conservation, as well as rescue interventions on monuments and

archaeological sites.
