Many legends were constructed in order to explain the origins of the Ottoman dynasty, which appeared “from nowhere” around 1300. In this lecture, we will examine the Ottoman state in its first steps during the fourteenth century, according to the historical sources. We will also examine the conflicting interpretations of modern historians concerning the nature of the early Ottoman state.

PAR 180-Prehistoric Cyprus

The topic of the course will be the archaeology of prehistoric Cyprus. The lectures will pick up from the earliest traces of habitation of the island during the Epi-palaeolithic and Neolithic periods (10.500-3900 BC), as well as the Chalcolithic (3900-2500 BC). The main focus of the course however will be on the Bronze Age (2500-1050 BC). Initially, the geography and ecological factors that characterize Cyprus will be discussed, and an emphasis will be placed on the geological data, such as copper ores and copper-producing areas, the metal that has defined the character of the island throughout its history.

The seminar will deal mostly with Bronze Age figurines from the Aegean, with an emphasis on Early Cycladic figurines (3rd mill. BC), Cretan of all ages (3rd-2nd mill. BC), and Mycenaean/post-Mycenaean figurines (2nd mill. BC).

Introduction to Greek vase-painting (Lecture course - KAR 113)

Lecture looks at the techniques and functions of painted ceramics as well as their subjects and styles, from the tenth to the fourth centuries BC. The study of iconography of painted vases give us a unique visual account of life and mythology of the greek polis, providing rich archaeological data for various aspects of ancient culture.

WS 2021 - Visual Arts (Vase Painting, mosaics) and the greek plays (Seminar)

The aim of this seminar is to study the variety and complexity of the interactions between ancient greek drama, tragedy and comedy - related, and vase painting of the classical period, especially on the South Italy and Sicily pots. Depictions in mosaic floors inspired by famous plays will be also considered. Beyond the examination of the popular subjects they appeal to the viewers, the costumes and stage facilities, questions of how visual arts and literature relate (whether they relate at all), or the ways of perception und understanding of greek plays are to be elicited within the frames of this course.
