**2nd Call for Student Mobility on the framework of
Blended Intensive Programme/BIP
Academic years 2025-2026 (call 2024)**

Title: Old and New Global Issues: Markets, Empires and Environment

Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students of the University of Crete (1st and 2nd cycle of studies) are invited to apply for blended intensive program mobility under the Erasmus+ framework.

In total: 4 eligible positions for students of the History and Archaeology Department of the University of Crete for the Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP), which is organized during the spring semester of the academic year 2025–2026 by the University of Lodz, Faculty of Economics and Sociology, Poland (1st and 2nd cycle of studies).

Requirements/ Academic background/ Level of studies

1. Students of the Department of History and Archaeology of the University of Crete (first and second cycle of studies)

2. They must have attended at least one seminar in Medieval History and/or Modern History

(Scoring 10-20: 10 points for a grade 5, 20 points for a grade of 10)

3. Very good knowledge of the English language (language proficiency certificate at least at B2 level). A higher-level language certificate will be positively evaluated.

Score: 10 points for B2

In case of a tie, possession of a higher-level certificates is taken into account.

4. Certificate of studies and recent transcript of records: the total number of courses successfully completed by the students, according to their year of study, will be taken into account (Score: 10 points for 50% of courses passed up to 20 points for 100% of courses passed), as well as the grade point average (Score: 15 points for average 5 up to 30 points for average 10)

In case of a tie, the total number of passed Medieval History and Modern History courses (lectures and seminars) is taken into account.

5. Curriculum Vitae: Score 5-10.

6. Motivation Letter: Score 5-10.

If a tie still remains after the evaluation of the above criteria, the Selection Committee conducts a draw.
