

Monetary Award of €2,000 and Student Housing & Meals Opportunities

The M.A. Programme in Ottoman History is pleased to announce that the top-ranked candidate, as determined by the Admissions Committee, will receive a monetary award of €2,000. The award will be paid in two instalments of €1,000 each: the first in autumn 2026, and the second in autumn 2027, provided that the recipient has successfully completed all first-year seminars and courses by that time.

The award is generously funded by Mr Ahmet Göksun in memory of his mother, Emel Göksun.

Candidates admitted to the Programme are also eligible to apply to the University of Crete for free accommodation and meals, subject to meeting the relevant income and other criteria. Applications may be submitted once students have completed their registration with the Department of History and Archaeology.
